

Classic Appreciation World Class Auto Detailing - Rochester

During the morning of March 21, a significant group of JAGM members (including two women) were treated to a master class in automotive detailing technology by Greg Swett, the owner of Classic Appreciation in downtown Rochester, MI. A sponsor of JAGM and an enthusiastic Jaguar guy, Greg demonstrated several new detailing techniques, including waterless car washes, polishing and scratch removal procedures, and the latest options in ceramic coatings.

JAGM members are a curious lot and are not afraid to ask questions. Greg not only answered them all, but went into extensive detail as to why he prefers to do things the way he does. For example, of all the many different power tools on the market, Greg prefers the old simple cotton buffer for many applications and believes the medium sized articulating polishers give the best results (i.e., don't go too small or too big on your wheel).

He also gave us long explanations on how to properly clean

up the interior of a car which has suffered smoke and/or water damage. He even had a current project in the shop to show us what he was talking about when it comes to tracking down and eliminating odors – not just covering them up with fragrances.

Ever the gracious host, Greg and his crew treated us to coffee and doughnuts on the front side of the event and made certain everybody got a departing gift. Many of us responded by buying a large number of detailing products on our way out the door. And JAGM rewarded Greg for his efforts with a solid gold XK120 for his display area.


