## THE INTERNATIONAL JAGUAR FESTIVAL IS CALLING. WE WANT YOU!

The International Jaguar Festival is coming to Pittsburgh and is integrated into the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix, with IJF-specific events from **Thursday, July 16 through Saturday, July 18, 2026**. To view the full schedule, visit [jaguarclubofpittsburgh.org](http://jaguarclubofpittsburgh.org) and select the International Jaguar Festival on the top ribbon.

Although the IJF runs Thursday through Saturday — ending Saturday afternoon on the Bob O'Connor Golf Course in Schenley Park — many guests will arrive as early as Tuesday or Wednesday. We therefore need volunteers from Wednesday through Saturday. JCOP members are asked to help with at least one assignment, even if only a couple of hours, staffing a Hospitality Table at one of three locations: the DoubleTree Pittsburgh-Cranberry Hotel (Wednesday–Friday), the Pittsburgh Golf Club during Friday's dinner, or the IJF tent on the golf course Saturday.

We also need at least three people (not necessarily JCOP members) who can direct parking near the Golf Club during the Friday dinner.



Additional volunteers are needed Friday to help prepare the car fields and on Saturday to guide trailer parking and direct cars to their assigned show spaces.

### **JCOP and PVGP Attend 2026 Pittsburgh Auto Show at the Convention Center!**

Our member, Amy Beck, owner of Hahn Auto Restoration and Dan DelBianco, Executive Director of the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix, kicked off our new season brilliantly by designing and setting up the PVGP Exhibit at the annual Auto Show featuring Jaguar, The Marque of the Year for PVGP in 2026 coming in July.

What better way to celebrate the upcoming “Jaguar-centric” series of festive events during July 11-18 which will also embed our club’s hosting of the JCNA International Jaguar Festival than featuring Jaguars at the city of Pittsburgh’s annual Auto Show!

Dan and his PVGP crew, Stu Benson, JCOP Chair, International Jaguar Festival and Amy with her team were on hand to meet and greet interested attendees at the exhibit and talk about this summer’s amazing events (covered last month in The Jaguar Jargon as well as this month on Page 1 and 2).

I had the pleasure of displaying my 1951 XK-120 alongside a 1968 E-Type 2+2 Coupe belonging to Sam Zacharias whose uncle took delivery of the car new in Belgium making it a one family-owned car with complete history!



Sam’s story is fascinating. When the car was new, Sam and his wife, Sophie, visited his Uncle Nick who literally provided its keys to the young couple so they could tour Europe during their visit in this amazing car at their leisure. They did so and upon their return, Sam was smitten – he made his uncle promise that if or when the car was ever sold, Sam would get first “option” to buy it. The promise became reality many years later when after the US spec E-Type was “repatriated” to the US and ultimately became Sam’s for real.

Though it sat many years of late, Hahn Restoration recommissioned the car to update its critical systems including brakes, suspension, chassis, engine tune and rubber parts including tires so that was ready at some point for the next gen! The car remains as a fully documented original with only 75,000 miles, making it a real time machine of great sentimentality to the family. Its award-winning design and lovely color combination of Opalescent Silver Blue with Dark Blue leather attracted many favorable, admiring comments among auto show viewers. An amazing story with a very happy ending.

The 120 “OTS” (open top sports) is a relatively early example representing Jaguar’s first famous post-WWII sports car that took the world by sensation when released in 1948 at the famous London Earl’s Court Auto Show. Designed by Sir William Lyons, the car was originally created as a showstopper platform to show off the newly developed XK dual overhead cam, aluminum head with hemispherical combustion chambered engine – intended for the big Jaguar saloons (sedans). Instead, Sir William received such acclaim along with persistent demand to produce the sports car, that Jaguar decided to do just that – making it an historical racing, and celebrity-owned success. In fact, Clark Gable and Gary Cooper, to name only two examples, became early owners of the car.

Like their cars, this example lived its life as a rust-free Los Angeles example sold originally by the famous western dealer/distributor, Hornburg Motors.



This car too, being 75 years old and the beneficiary of a 30-year-old body-off-frame restoration updated, serviced and maintained by Hahn Restoration was the object of enthusiastic questions and discussions, by many young people who had never seen one or even heard of the car before! Its distinctive Birch Gray color and red leather trim make it a bit unusual compared to the more frequently seen red, silver or green examples. It doesn't hurt that Jaguar advertised the 120 (named to cite approximately its top speed) was test driven and raced to prove that at a relatively reasonable price, the car in the early 50's was able to live up to its ad copy as indeed “the fastest production sports car in the world.”

This car has been on the Jaguar Club local, regional and national show circuit every few years since 1996, being a trophy winner champion given its care and preservation as a sports car icon.

Thanks to Amy and Dan for setting up the display to honor Jaguar in such an elegant and attractive manner. It was fun to be part of the “big show.”

## 1966 Jaguar Mk2 Restoration – Part 20

OK. Fess up. Who made this mess? Was it you, 22-year-old Ford Ranger? “No. Not me. I’m too busy leaving rust stains on the driveway.”

How about you, 2023 Mazda? “No. Not me either. That looks like motor oil on the floor. I only leak SkyActive Fluid from my transmission.”


That leaves you, 1966 Jaguar Mk 2. The trail of oil is pretty damning evidence. “Yes. It was me. It’s embarrassing but what I think happened is that it was cold, my oil was very viscous, and my oil filter housing was not perfectly centered on the unforgivingly small seal surface. The high pressure oil pushed out the seal and I pumped oil all over the floor. Sorry.”

It was a nice day and I had a few hours. Time to get the car off the skates, started and driven outside to get some pictures in anticipation of starting the Pennsylvania registration process. This led to the puddle of oil on the floor.

Once the pictures were taken, the car was pushed back into the garage, the oil spill was cleaned up, the leak was addressed. Fortunately, I had a few extra seals for the oil filter assembly. After a couple of failed attempts, I was able to center the filter canister on the seal, eliminating the leak. I’m hoping it does not blow out again the next time the oil is cold.

Progress continues on the interior. It is essentially done except for a couple of carpets, the dash top and the shifter boot on the center consol. Since my car was originally an automatic, the interior kit did not include a shifter boot. I reached out to OSJI, formerly G. W. Bartlett who supplied the interior kit that came with my car. They were very helpful and sent me some material samples to make sure the color matched. It was a perfect match so I ordered the shift boot for a very reasonable \$29 plus shipping. I now have everything to complete the consol.

I decided to just replace the clutch master cylinder. It was slowly dripping into the foot well area and new seals did not solve the problem. I didn’t want the fluid to ruin the new carpets once the “diaper” was removed. Installation is pretty straight forward.

Bleeding the system was accomplished with help from Mrs. G. who, I think, secretly enjoys coming out to the garage in the cold to push the pedal but she does a good job of hiding her excitement.



I still have a couple of miscellaneous leaks. One brake caliper continues to frustrate, and the thermostat housing gasket is leaking coolant. I'm going to have to take that off and change it out as I am afraid to try to tighten it any further. The fuel system is tight and the power steering seems to be leak free, finally.

I really need to get my seats back from the upholstery shop. I have learned that under no circumstance should you tell a service provider that you are not in a hurry. When the seats were collected in October and I said "I'm not in a hurry, by Christmas will be fine" I did not anticipate that I would still be waiting in March.

Finally, thanks to the very cold weather, I started on a project that could be completed in my basement. I have taken the tool kit apart and stripped the paint off the housing. The parts soaked in rust remover for a few days and received a new coat of paint and are now ready for reassembly. I have all the tools except the 4 inch adjustable wrench, which I am actively looking for. *(See tool kit photo at right.)*

The 2026 International Jaguar Festival (IJF) will be part of the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix (PVGP). The Concours d'Elegance will take place on the Bob O'Connor golf course on July 18. Trophies will be awarded for the top 3 highest scoring Jaguars in each class of the Champion, Driven and Special divisions. The Concours will be held in accordance with the current JCNA rules.

The PVGP has been held annually since 1983 and features the only vintage races in the United States run on public streets. Time trials are run on Saturday with the races on Sunday. The PVGP is a 10-day celebration with many car related events.

**What to expect.** The members of the Jaguar Club of Pittsburgh will be your host not only to the concours, but events that may be of particular interest to our guests.

The following 3 events will have the races' Grand Marshal, **Ian Callum**, as our special guest.

Thursday Grand Prix Garden Party held at the Phipps Conservatory

Friday dinner held at the Pittsburgh Golf Club

Saturday Concours d'Elegance with Mr. Callum presenting the awards.

If you want to participate in the week's events, but you would rather display your Jaguar you can enter the "Marque of the Year".

**All payments for the events will be handled by the PVGP by way of their website. Once you have made your payment for the concours through Vivenu, you can complete the concours application on pages 9 and 10 of this issue instead of printing them from the webpage.**

**Show Closure:** Where/when the number of entrants submitted to the Chief Judge reaches the capacity of the show field.
