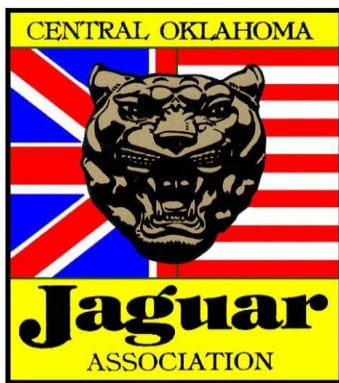

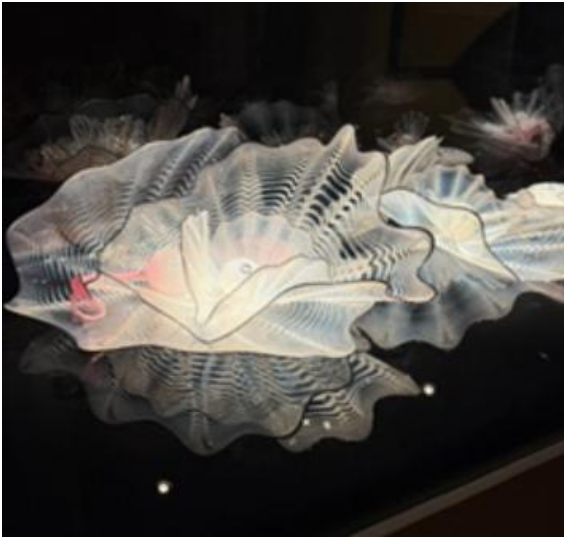
OKLAHOMA CITY MUSEUM OF ART

Your August event will be a personal tour of the new Oklahoma National Guard Museum built in 2026 to replace the 45th Infantry Division Museum created in 1974 that was housed in the Lincoln Park Armory built by WPA in 1936. The new museum is 39,375 square feet of which 20,000 square feet houses the exhibits and 10,000 square feet is dedicated to an event and education center.

We will meet August 22nd, at 10:00 AM at the front doors of the Oklahoma National Guard Museum, 3301 NE Grand Blvd, OKC OK 73111. Why? Because it opens at 10:00 AM for a personal tour by Jim Sena. Jim is an experienced docent, and I look forward to hearing Jim tell us about the exhibits and the insights behind those collections and how the museum operates.

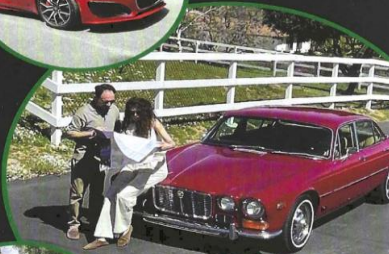

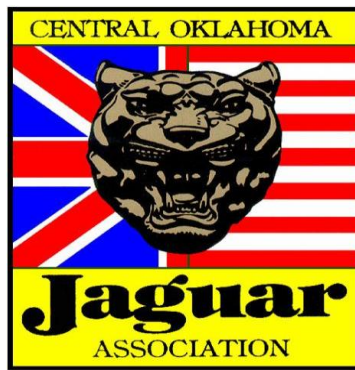
